RULES & REGULATIONS :-

1. The Barbeque Pit is opened from 9.00am to 10.00pm (daily).
2. Bookings must be made in person at the Management Office on a first-come-first-served basis and shall be made on a prescribed form.
3. Bookings can be made up to one (1) month in advance upon payment of a **\$100.00** deposit. It shall be made payable to "Management Corporation Strata Title Plan No 3882".
4. **All cash or cheque deposit made will be banked in once booking is confirmed.**
5. The deposit will be returned provided the premises used are handed back in a clean, satisfactory and undamaged condition as determined by the Management. The cost of repairs, cleaning or other additional charges, if any, will be deducted from the deposit and the balance will be refunded, free of interest, to the resident. However, if the cost of repairs, cleaning or other additional charges should exceed the amount deposited, the resident shall have to pay, additionally, the difference.
6. Deposit will be refunded via cheque upon submitting the original receipt to the Management Office.
7. **Refund of deposit will take 30 working days.**
7. Bookings are limited to a maximum of one (1) session per month.
8. Live bands and mobile discos are not permitted. Portable radio, cassette and CD players are permitted at the barbecue area provided there are no complaints from Residents and the Management Reserves the right to authorise the removal of any of these equipment should it deem fit.
9. Highly flammable equipment and portable barbecue burners are not permitted at the Barbecue Pavilions.
10. Gambling, mah-jong, card games and any forms of gambling are strictly prohibited.
11. All unwanted leftover food, litter, etc. must be disposed into trash bins provided. Washing of barbecue utensils, equipment, cutlery or crockery is not allowed at the changing rooms or on pool deck.
12. Residents and their guests must ensure that the barbecue pits and its surroundings are left in a clean and tidy condition after use.
